POLICY FOR DIFFERENTLY ABLED

In 2017, Ansar Women's College formally approved the following policy for Differently Abled. This policy intends to help six major categories: wheelchair users, people with limited walking abilities, the sightless and the partially sighted, the hearing impaired, people with difficulties in learning and those persons who are temporarily disabled.

Aims

- 1. Provide a friendly and caring atmosphere for differently abled.
- 2. Provide equal educational opportunities for differently abled.
- 3. Provide special devices to augment the learning experience of differently abled.
- 4. To provide wheelchair-accessible classrooms
- 5. Provide guidance, counselling and extra classes for differently abled.
- 6. Gathering orders dealing with fee concessions, examination procedures, reservation policies etc for differently abled students
- 7. The student volunteers will be deputed as scribes to help differently abled.
- 8. Assist differently-abled graduates to gain successful employment in the public as well as private sectors.
- 9. Observation of important days pertaining to disability such as World Disabled day in the institution and also in the neighbouring institutions in order to create awareness about capabilities of differently abled persons.
