POLICY FOR ENVIRONMENT AND ENERGY PROTOCOL

In 2012, Ansar Women's College formally approved the following Campus Environment Energy Initiative as College policy.

The mission is to reduce energy consumption, assure acceptable indoor air quality, and improve energy efficiency in campus through methods that are consistent with a safe, secure, and inviting campus community. Energy conservation will be accomplished by developing a progressive approach to provide energy efficient, responsible, and cost-effective operations in the campus. The success of the initiative will be evaluated periodically through environmental audits that evaluate its progress in achieving the following goals.

Goals

- 1. Ensure the maximum use of LED bulbs in the college.
- 2. Encourage students and staff to make use of public transport.
- 3. Encourage students and staff residing in the locality to avoid vehicles.
- 4. The institution observes environment and energy conservation days to create awareness among students, faculty members and among public.
- 5. Support local bodies in designing and implementing save energy initiatives.
- 6. Support State and Central government to save energy.
