International Youth Day

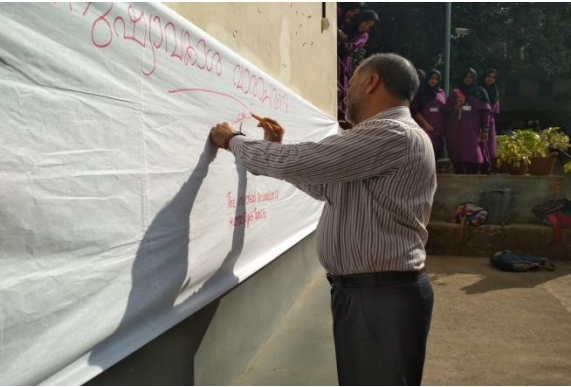
