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AWC SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME

Ansar Women's College, run by Ansari Charitable Trust, is dedicated to empowering and supporting talented and deserving women in pursuing their education and achieving their academic and professional goals. As part of our commitment to fostering excellence in arts and sciences, we are pleased to introduce our Scholarship Scheme for our students.

Eligibility Criteria

- 1. Applicants must be female students enrolled in the arts and science program at Ansar Women's College.
- 2. The scholarship is open to both undergraduate and postgraduate students.
- 3. Applicants must demonstrate outstanding academic performance and a passion for their chosen field of study.
- 4. Financial need may be taken into consideration, but the scholarship is primarily merit-
- 5. Orphans, students of Single Parents, financially backward students, SC/ST students will be given priority.
- 6. Applicants must have a good disciplinary record and demonstrate exemplary conduct within the college community. Once the students becomes academically backward and exhibits unhealthy behaviour in the College Campus, the Scholarship will be stopped.
- 7. Scholarship will be given from the second year onwards, after a thorough examination of students in the first year of their study.
- 8. The recipients of scholarship are expected to support the college with sponsorship of poor students in future once they become employed.

Scholarship Details

- 1. The scholarship will cover a portion or the entirety of the recipient's tuition fees for the academic year.
- 2. The number and value of scholarships awarded each year will be determined by the College, taking into account available funds and the quantity of applicants.
- 3. The scholarship may be renewed annually, subject to the recipient's academic performance and adherence to college policies.
- 4. For the students who scored 96 percentage of marks or above in the qualifying examination, full scholarship will be given. For the students who scored 90-95 percentage of marks in the qualifying examination, 50 percentage of scholarship will be given. For the students who scored 85-90 percentage of marks in the qualifying examination, 20 percentage of scholarship will be given. For promoting science education, full scholarship will be given to deserving candidates for selected UG Programs in science subjects. For the financially and socially backward students, full scholarship will be given irrespective of their academic achievement in the qualifying examinations.

5. In case of sponsorship, the sponsors will be intimated the progress of the academics of the recipients.

Application Process

- 1. Interested applicants should complete the official scholarship application form, which can be obtained from AWC website.
- 2. Along with the application form, applicants must submit the following documents
 - a. A copy of their most recent academic transcript.
 - b. A personal statement outlining their academic and career goals, their passion for arts and sciences, and how the scholarship will support their aspirations (maximum 200 words).
 - c. A letters of recommendation from academic referees who can speak to the applicant's abilities and potential.
 - d. Any additional supporting documents, such as certificates of achievement, relevant extracurricular activities, or evidence of financial need (if applicable).
- 3. Completed application packages should be submitted to the Coordinator, Scholarship Cell by the specified deadline. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

Selection Process

- 1. A scholarship committee, comprising of Coordinator of Scholarship Cell, Mentor, Class Teacher, Head of the Department, Vice Principal and Principal will review all eligible applications.
- 2. The selection process will take into account academic merit, the strength of the personal statement, letters of recommendation, and any supporting documents.
- 3. In order to verify the reliability of the application, the mentor will visit the house of the applicants and the report will be sent to the class teacher. The class teacher will forward this to Head of the Department. Head of the Department will make a recommendation to the Principal. Once the Principal recommends the scholarship, recipients will be shortlisted.
- 4. Shortlisted candidates may be invited for an interview or additional assessment to further evaluate their suitability for the scholarship.
- 5. The final decision regarding scholarship recipients will be made by the Management Committee, and all applicants will be notified of the outcome.

We believe that education is a powerful tool for women's empowerment, and through our Scholarship Scheme, we aim to provide opportunities for talented women to excel in their academic pursuits. We encourage all eligible students to apply and look forward to supporting their educational journey.
