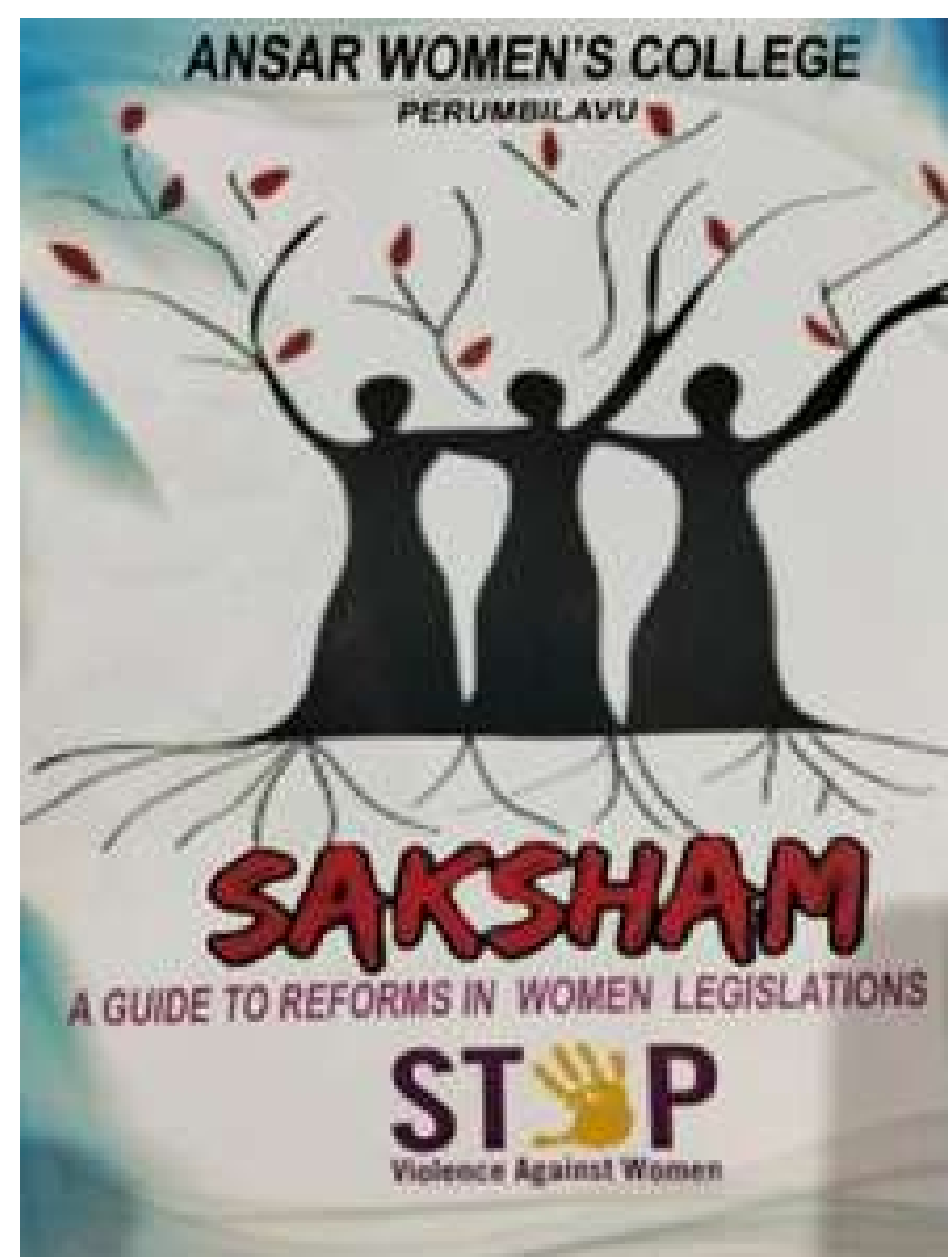


SAKSHAM

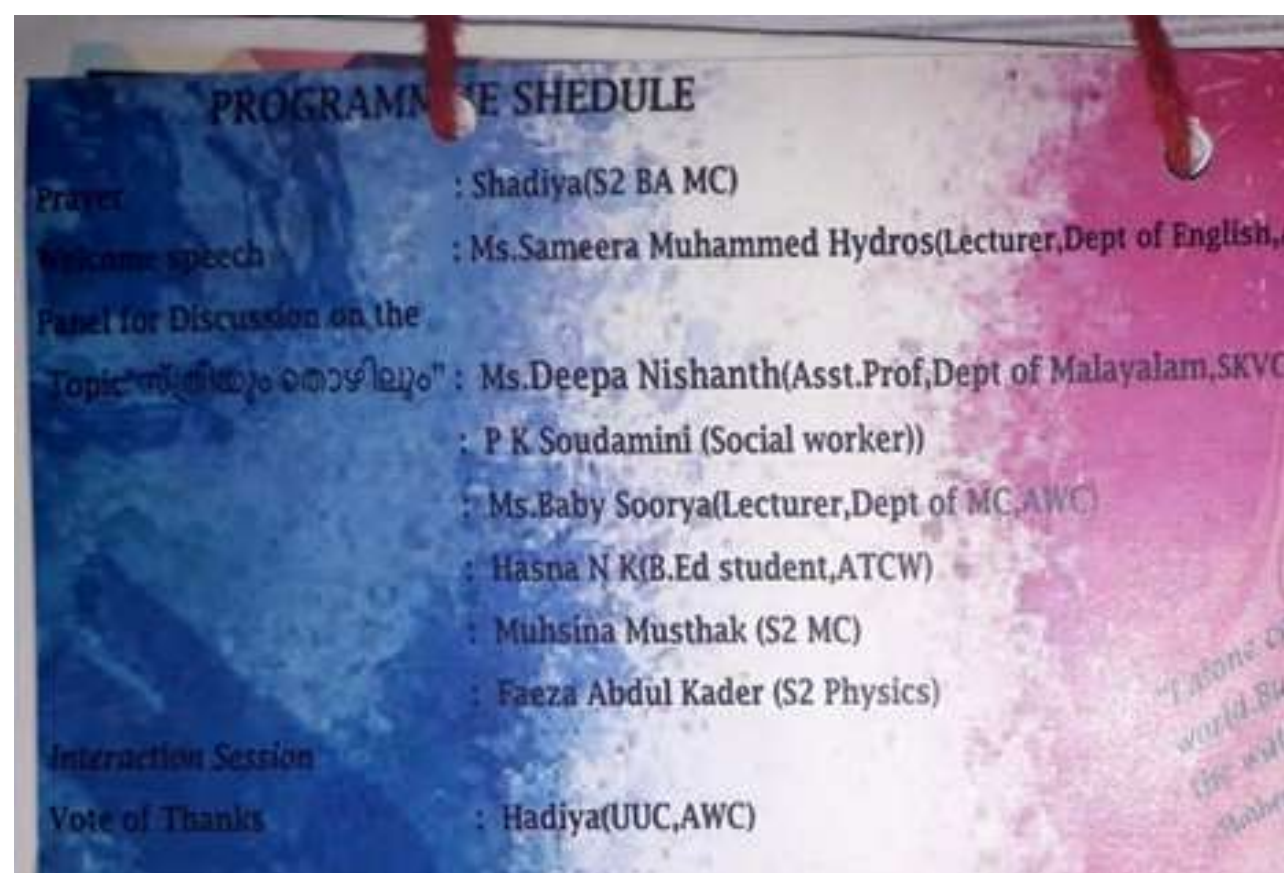

GYNAEC AWARENESS CLASS

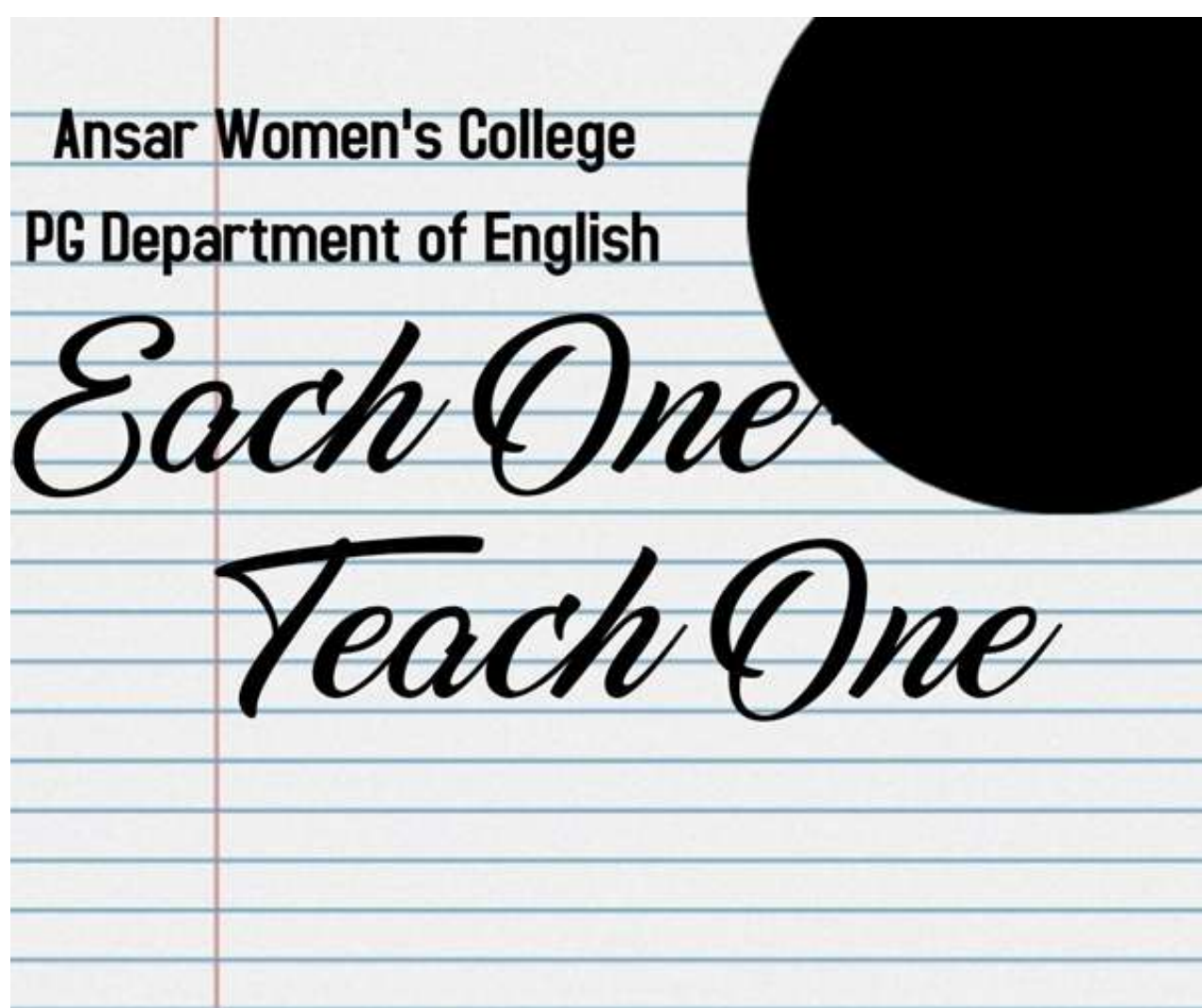
HEALTHY WOMEN EMPOWERED WOMEN

Many students enthusiastically participated in the competition. Class wise competition is held. 8 students can participate on behalf of the class. The students made star lanterns passionately.

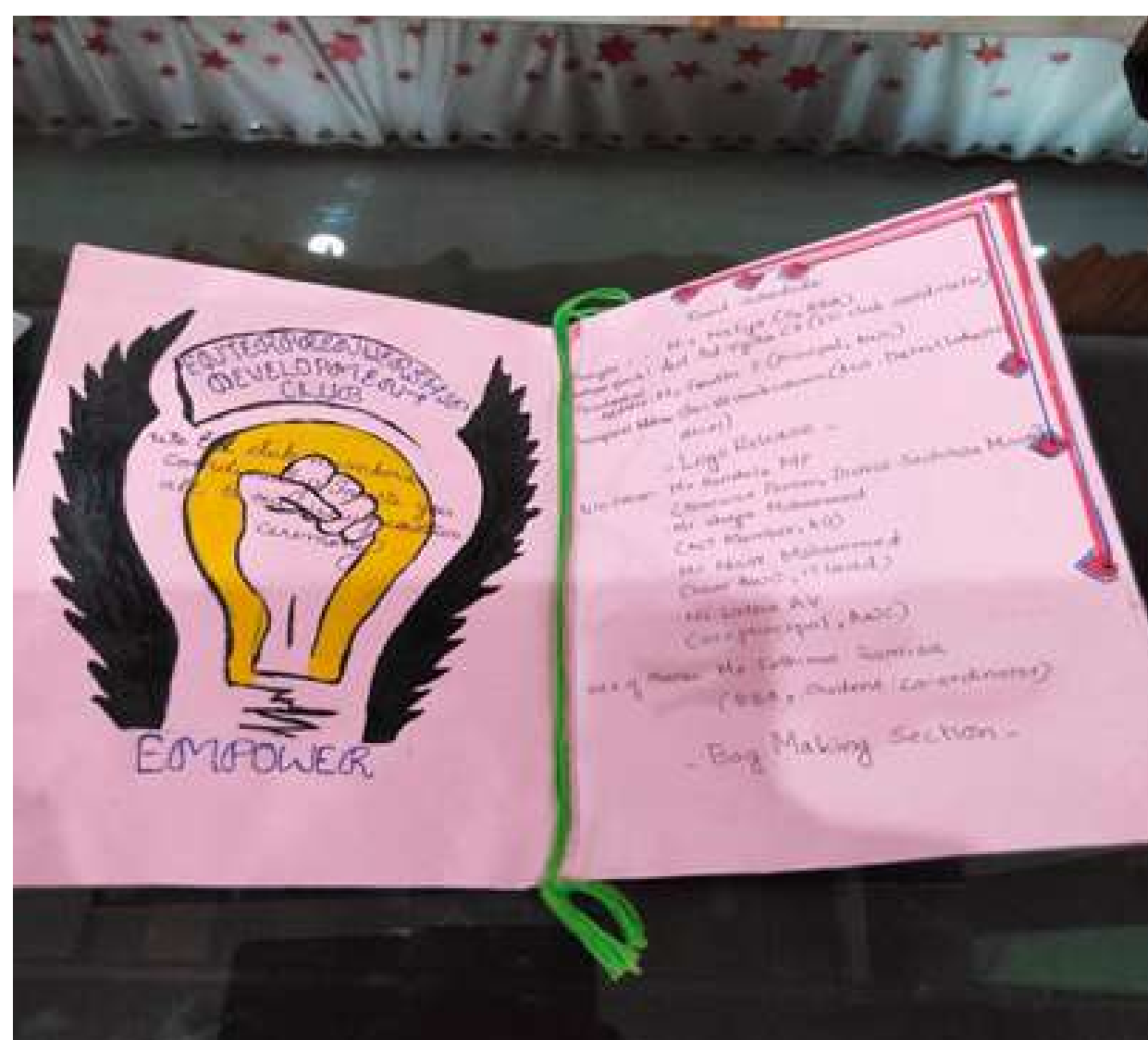
CLOTH BAG MAKING ONE DAY SEMINAR

Within five days the students created 200 pens in total. The workshop helped in creating environmental awareness and also to improve the creative ideas of students.

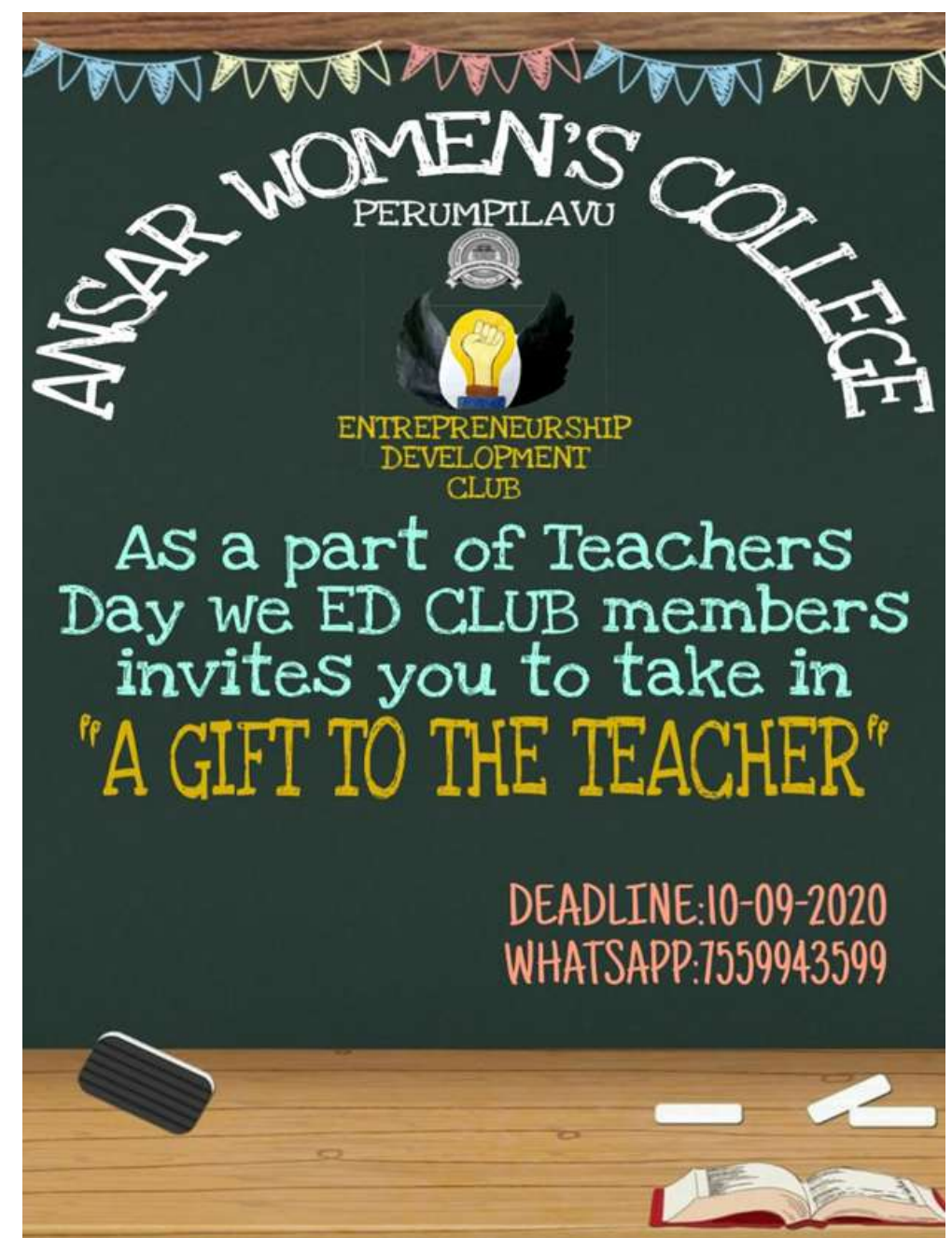
SEWING MACHINE

A GIFT TO THE TEACHER COMPETITION

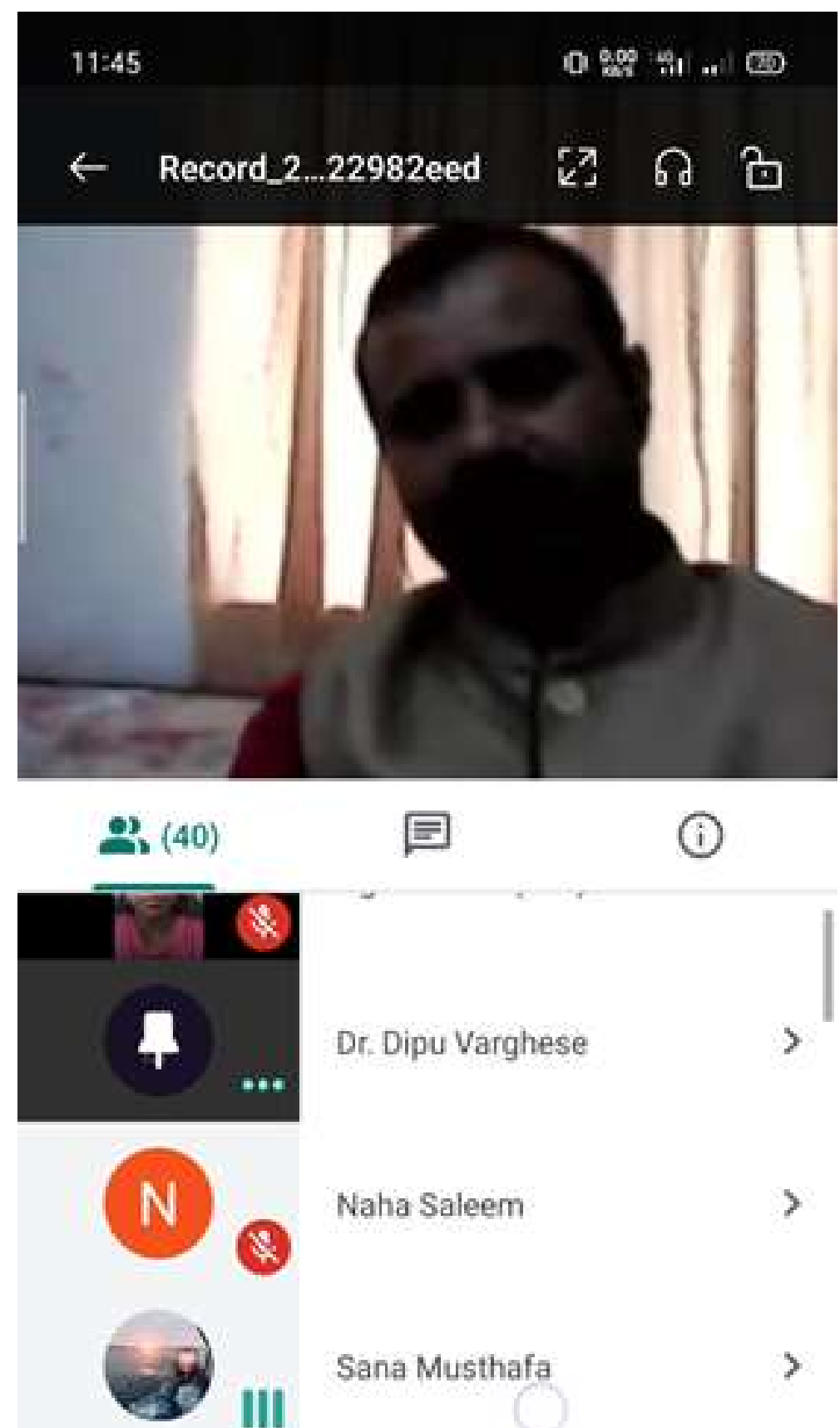

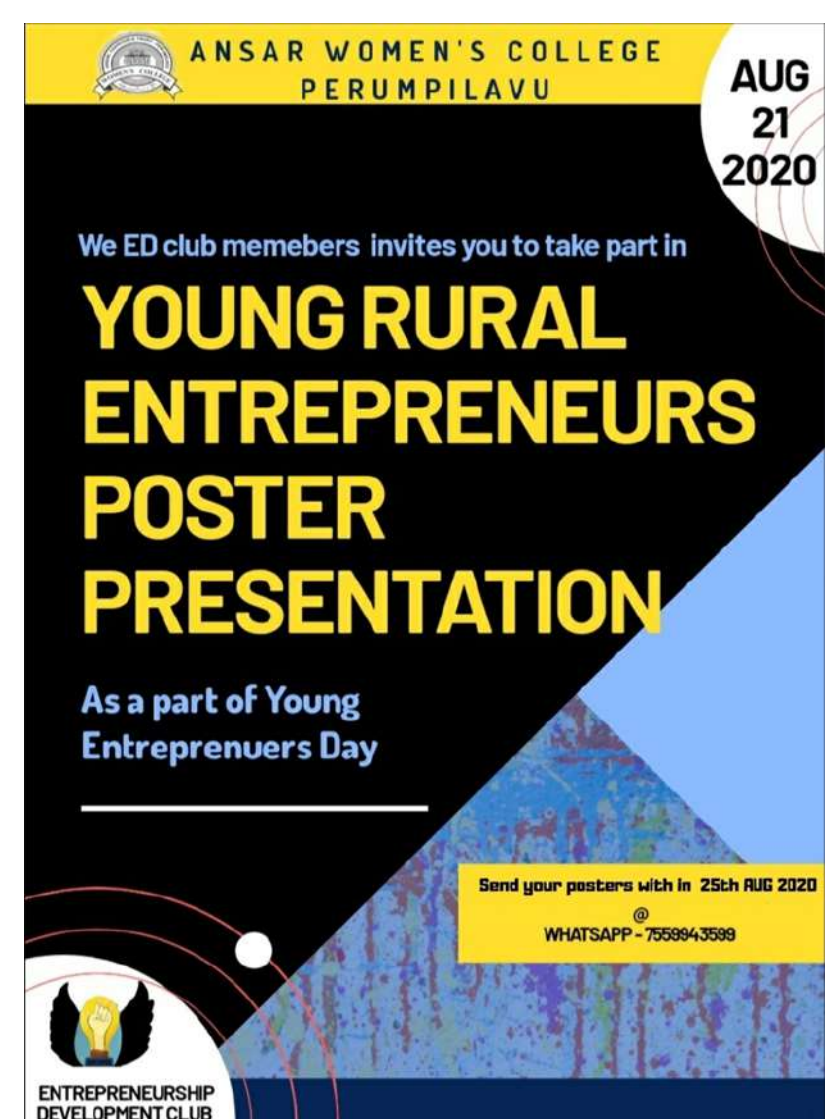

The department of Mathematics conducted their faculty development programme by inviting a resources person to train the teachers in modern ways of teaching maths to the studnet's.

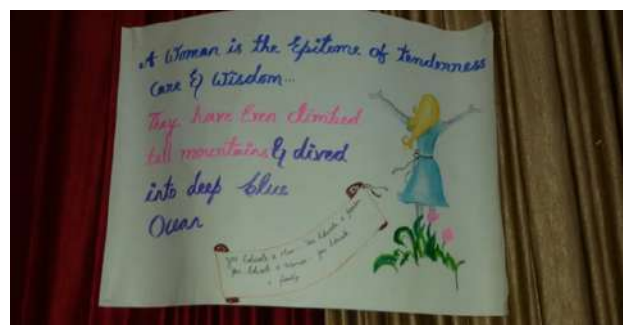
DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH
