UG PROGRAMMES UNDER FYUGP

CUFYUGP SHALL HAVE THREE BROAD PATHWAYS

1. THREE-YEAR UG PROGRAMME

- ◆ Minimum 133 credits (max. 180 credits)
- ◆ The student will have to do a two-year PG programme

2. FOUR-YEAR UG PROGRAMME: UG HONOURS

- ◆ Minimum 177 credits (max. 240 credits)
- ◆ The student will have to do a one-year PG programme
- ◆ In the fourth year, the student has to do 11 courses or 9 courses and an optional Project of 6 credits

3. FOUR-YEAR UG PROGRAMME: UG HONOURS WITH RESEARCH

- ◆ Minimum 177 credits (max. 240 credits)
- ◆ The student can opt to do a one-year PG programme or can join directly for PhD programme
- ◆ In the fourth year the student should have a mandatory Research Project of 12 credits

ADMISSION

Online registration under centralized admission process (CAP) of the University of Calicut is compulsory. College application for admission can be had from the college office on payment of Rs. 500/- in person. Cheques and DDs will not be accepted. Attested copies of marks/SSLC or qualifying examination should be submitted along with the application for admission. All the candidates should produce the CAP print out along with the college form at the time of admission. The candidates who do not appear for interview on the day and time assigned to them will not be eligible for admission. Admission will be finalized only after the interview. The parents/guardians should be present at the time of interview.



Candidates seeking admission should produce the following documents at the time of interview:

- ◆ Qualifying certificates – Higher Secondary / Senior Secondary / Pre-Degree / VHSE / Degree Marklist with three photocopies of the same.
- ◆ Three copies of SSLC / CBSE
- ◆ Three copies of recent passport size Photograph
- ◆ TC from the institution last attended with three attested photocopies of the same
- ◆ Conduct Certificate from the Head of the institution last attended
- ◆ Genuineness certificate (in case of NIOS)
- ◆ Equivalency certificate (Board other than state)
- ◆ Community certificates (For daughters of Ex-service men & Freedom Fighters, NSS, NCC & Arts & Sports etc. and certificates proving physical disabilities, if any, should be attached along with the application form)

Original certificates need to be submitted at the time of interview. Students are advised to keep enough attested copies of certificates for their future use.

ANSAR SPECIAL SERVICES

I. EMOTIONAL FIRST AID SERVICE

Emotional First Aid is a crucial service of Ansar Women's College to help students cope with emotional distress. By offering counselling services and mental health education and training, Ansar creates a safe and supportive environment for students to talk about their feelings and get the resources they need to feel better. Thus, Emotional First Aid Services helps students feel more connected to their college community, more empowered to take control of their mental health, and more prepared to thrive academically and personally. This service is open to teachers and parents also.

II. ECG (EDUCATION AND CAREER GROWTH) SERVICE

A. Ansar Civil Service Academy Ansar

Civil Service Academy provides students with information about the civil service examination, its structure, and the different career options that are available to successful candidates. It creates a structured learning environment that can help students stay focused and motivated, gives personalized attention from experienced mentors, and offers the opportunity to interact with other peers who are preparing for the same exam and give students a competitive edge by providing them the : confidence to succeed in the Civil Services Exams. B. PSC Coaching Classes

AWC takes the responsibility of the online registration of all students for writing PSC examinations and provides PSC Coaching Classes to students who are interested in pursuing a career in the public sector. These sessions provide them with the necessary skills, knowledge, and the expert support to hone the PSC classes conduct on Saturdays.

C. Career Counselling Sessions

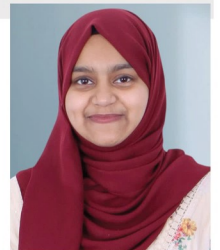
AWC Alumni Community is spreading all around the globe. In order to foster closer interactions and networking among them, regional associations have been formed and more are being considered.
