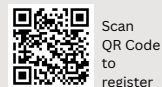

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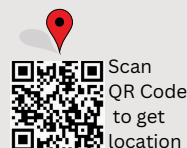

- All submissions must be neatly typed in English in MS Word with Times New Roman font style, 12 font size, 1.5 line spacing, and should be in PDF format.

- The maximum number of authors permitted per paper is two. Registration should be undertaken separately in case of two authors.

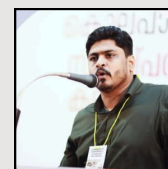

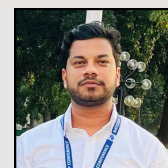

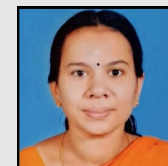
