WEBINAR 2020



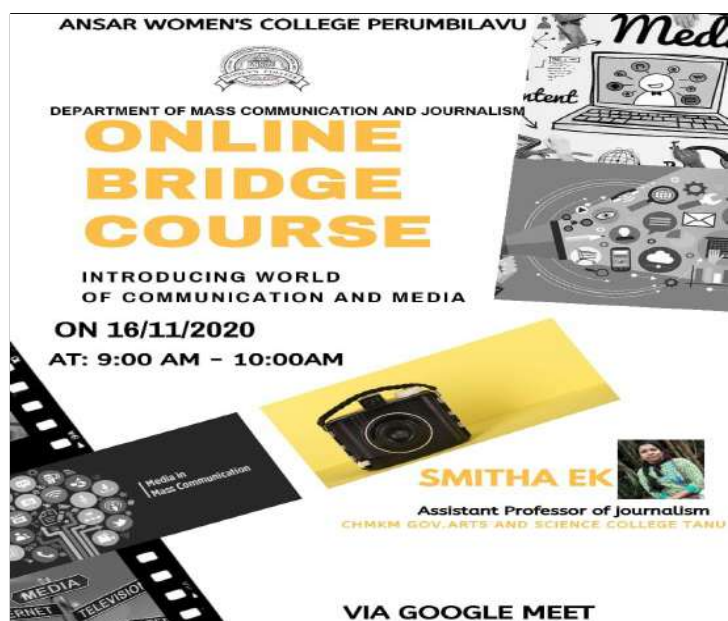

A Photo collage competition was conducted based on Environment day and students were asked to merge the photos and make a meaningful sentence and competition was open from 21st till 27th of May.



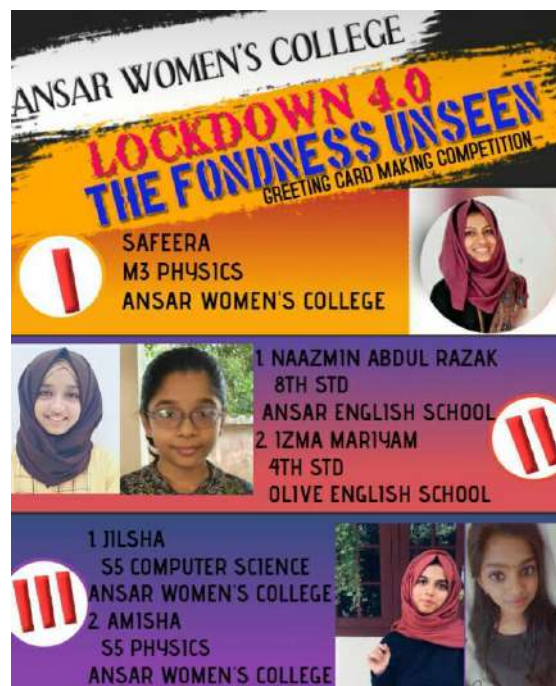
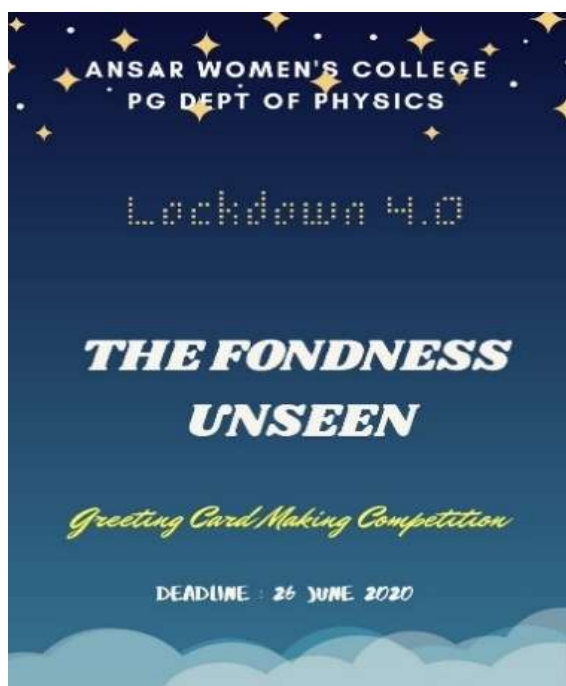
LOCKDOWN 4.0– Smash with Trash Video Contest

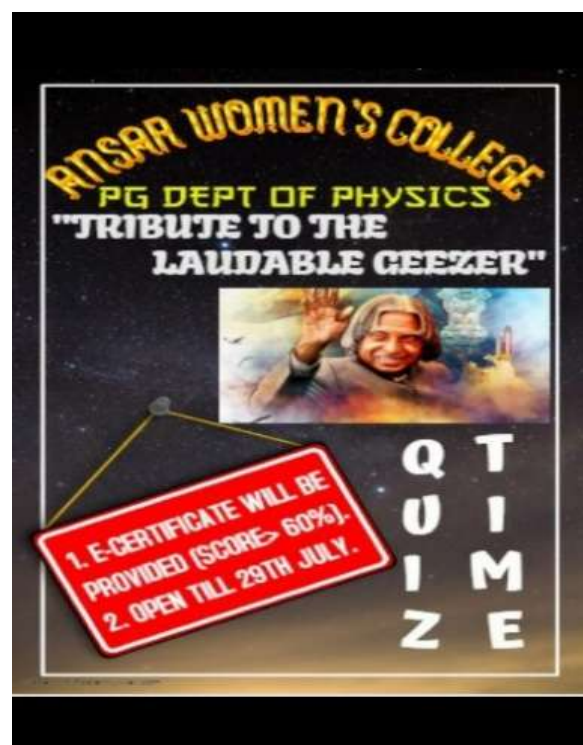
LOCKDOWN 4.0– Fondness Unseen : Greeting Card Making Competition

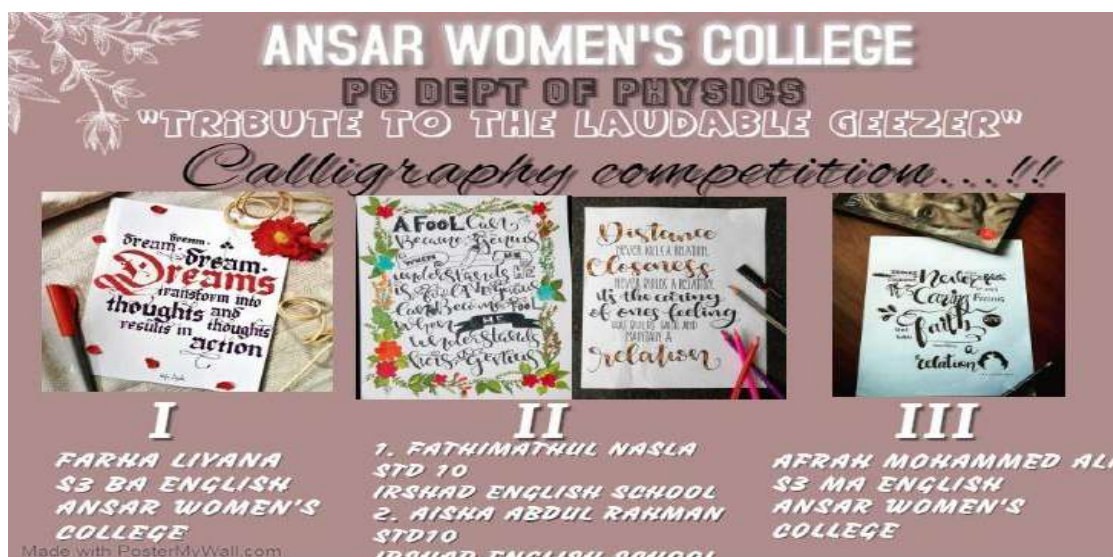

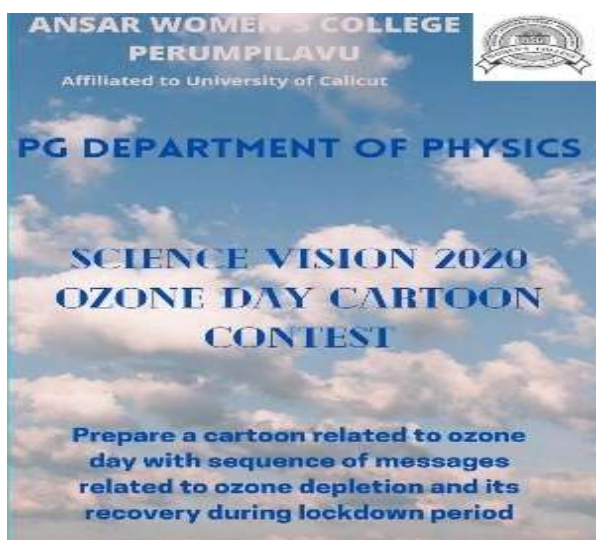

Ozone Day: cartoon making Competition

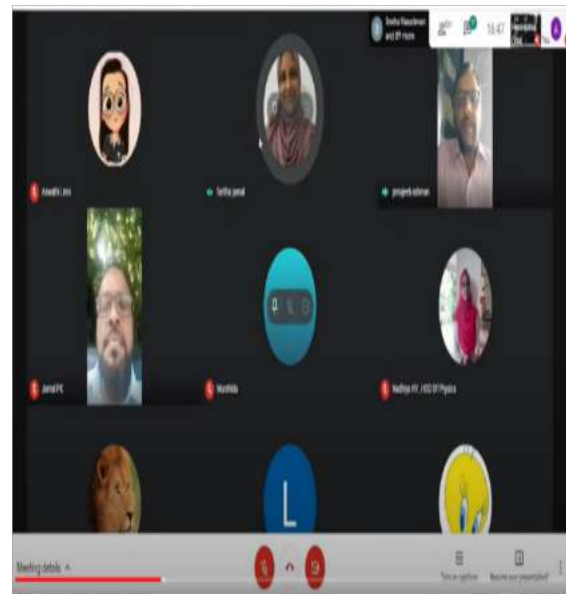

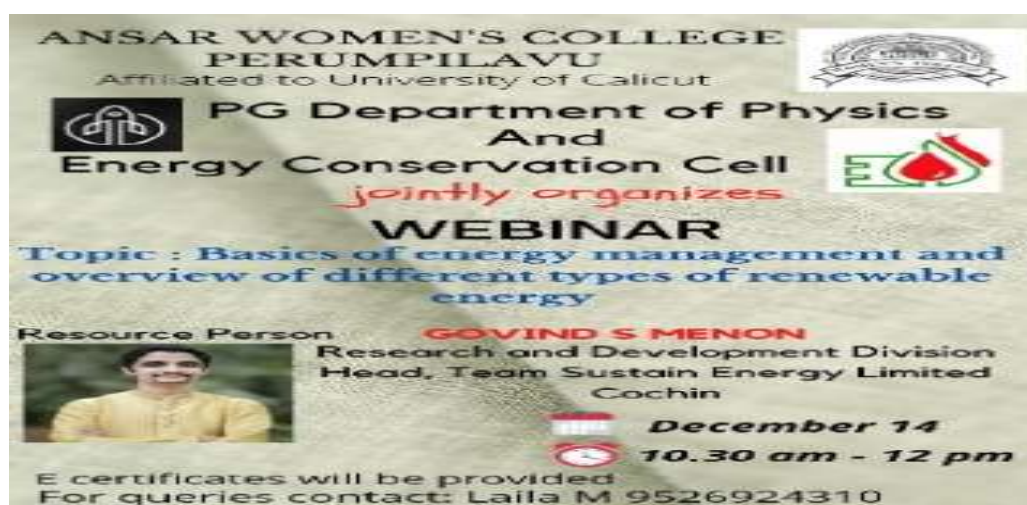


Webinar on Energy Conservation Day

International Webinar On International day for women in science

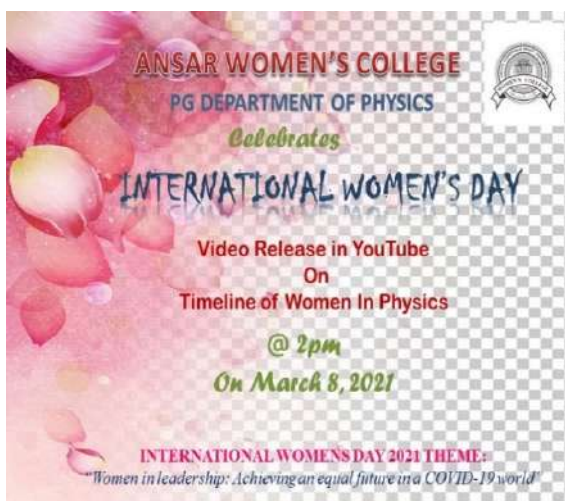

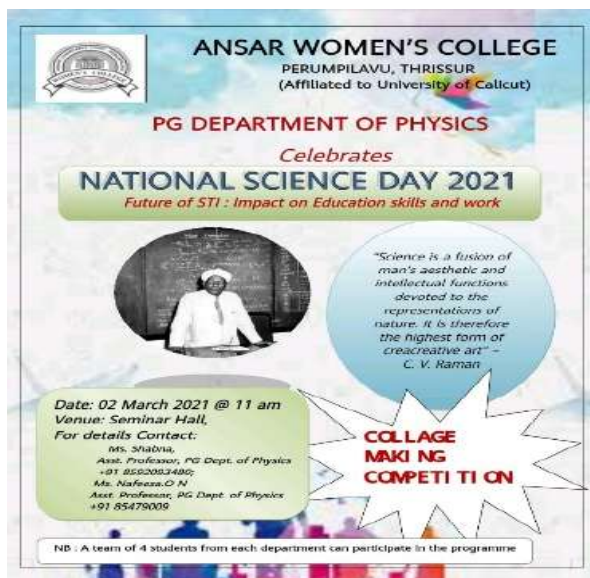

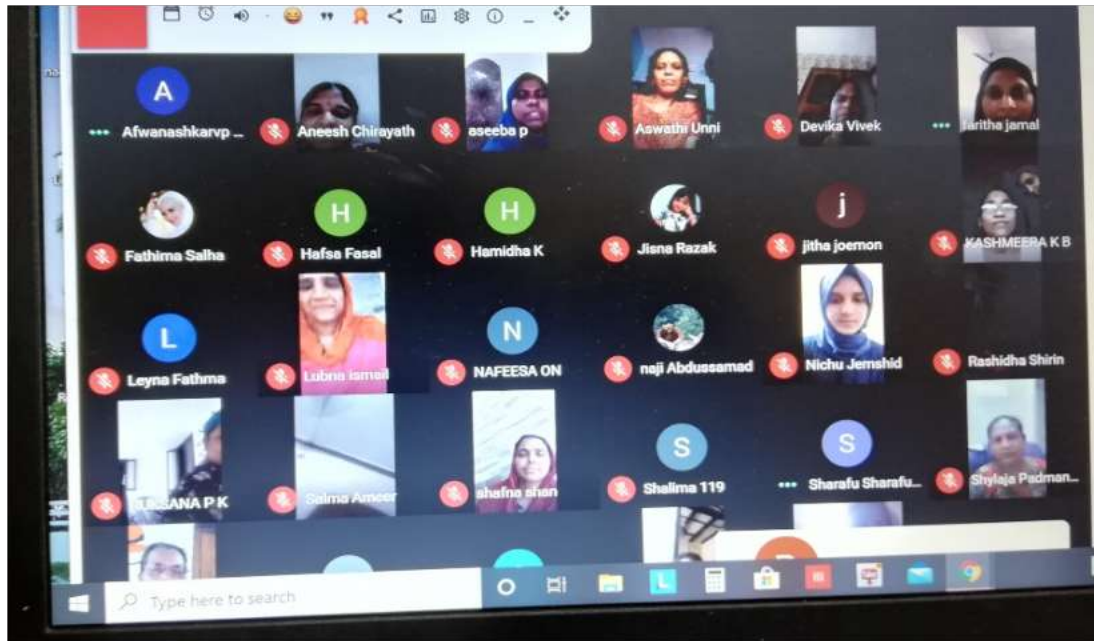
The National science day was celebrated on 2nd March 2021 at our college. Many students from all the departments participated in the event as a group of four members.

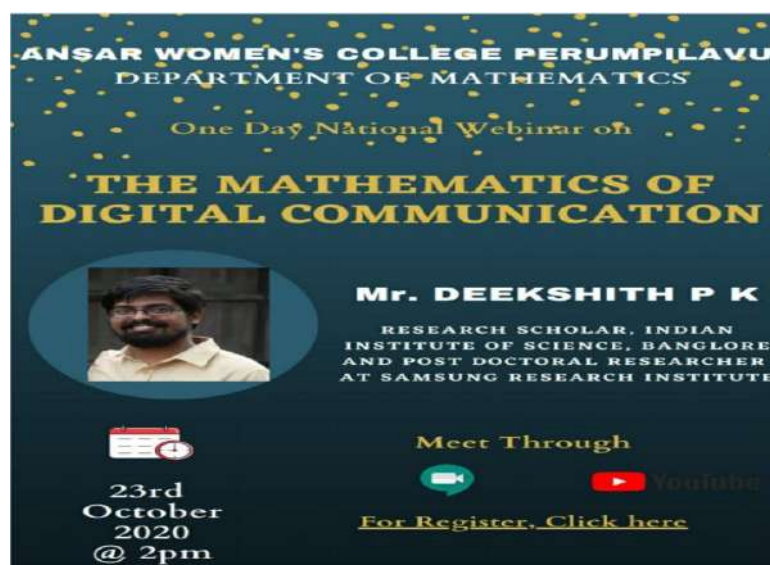

PATRIOTIC SONG COMPETITION

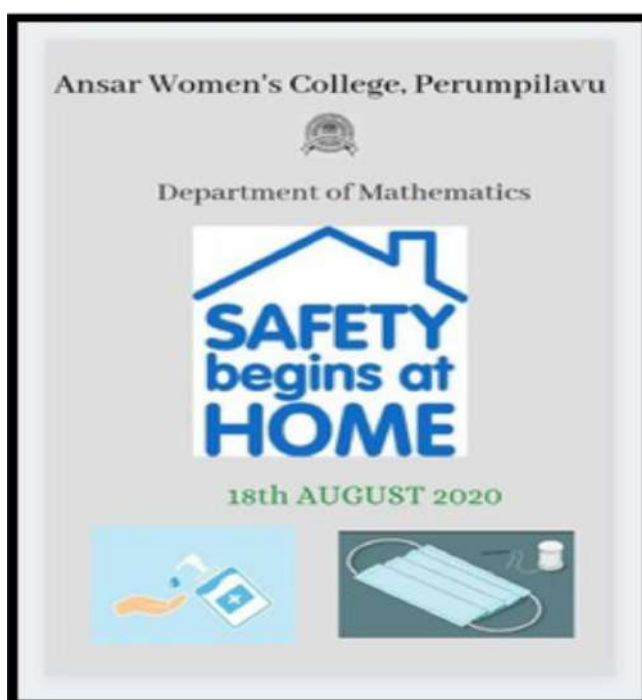

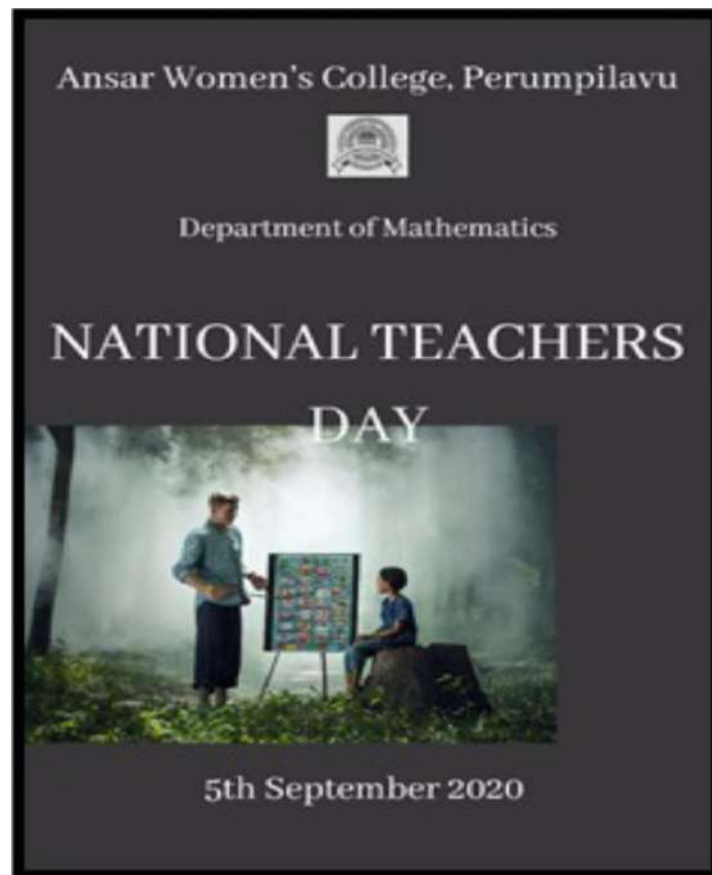
E-ONAM

As a part of Onam celebration, the final year students of the department released a dance video on 18th August 2020. The students had shown active and energetic participation in the program.



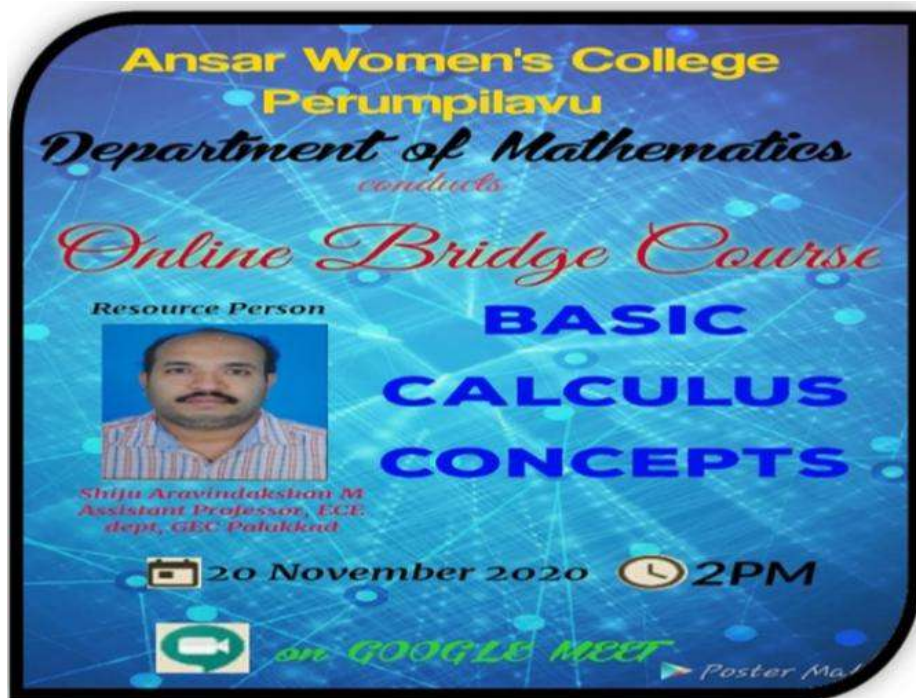
TEACHER'S DAY

BRIDGE COURSE

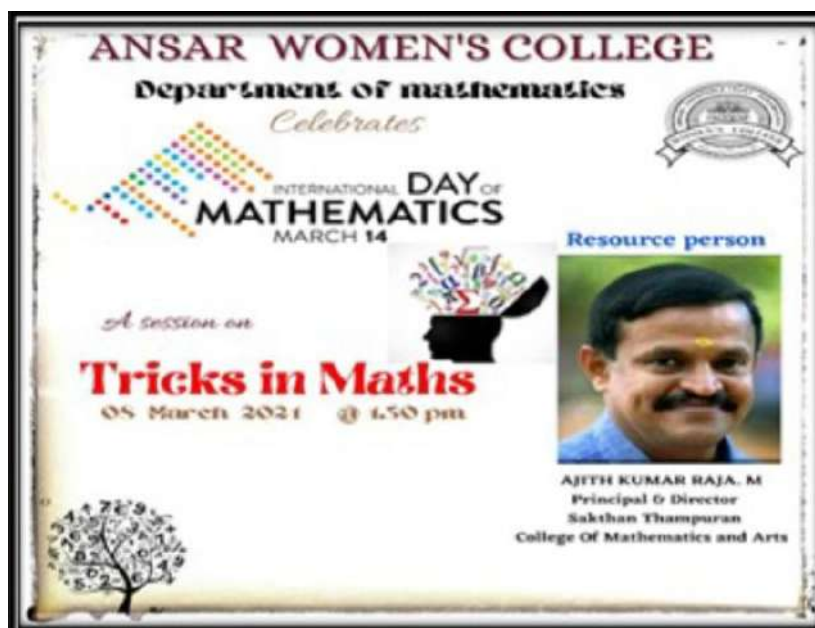

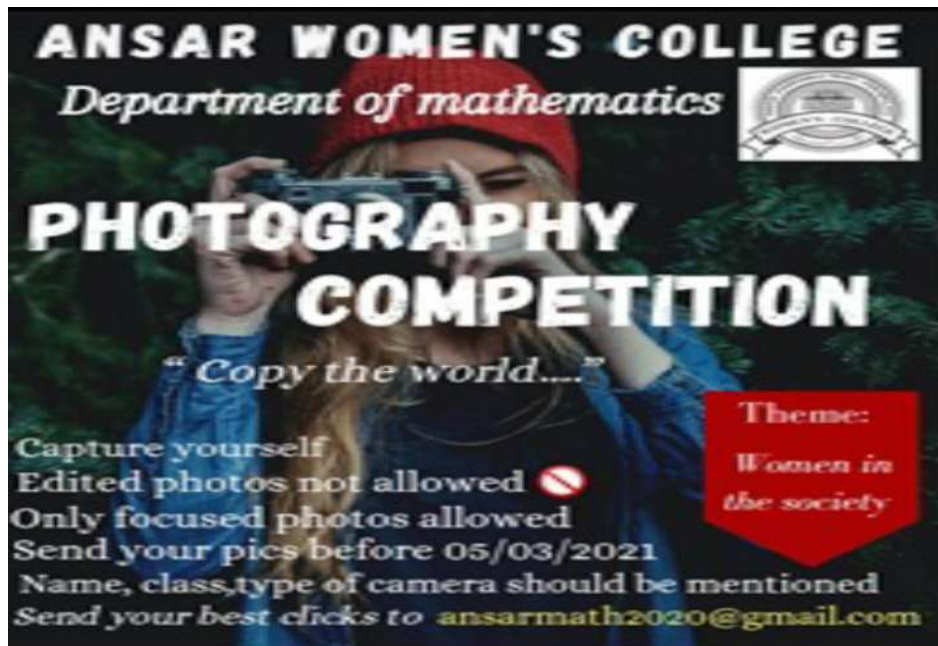

Remedial coaching - Coaching for Advanced Learner provided classes to the students through online and offline modes.



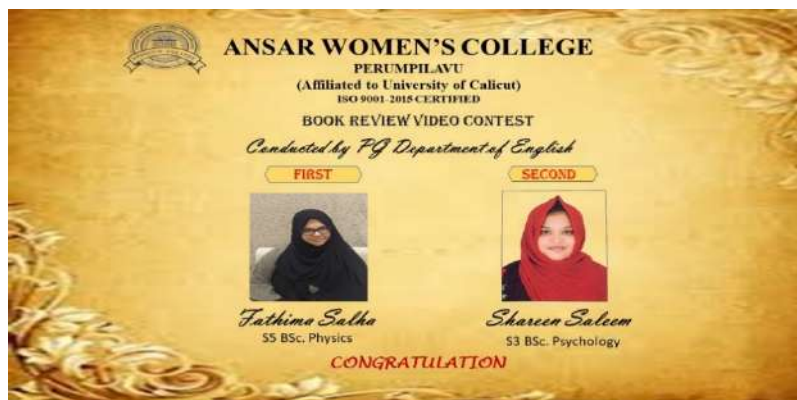
CERTIFICATE COURSE

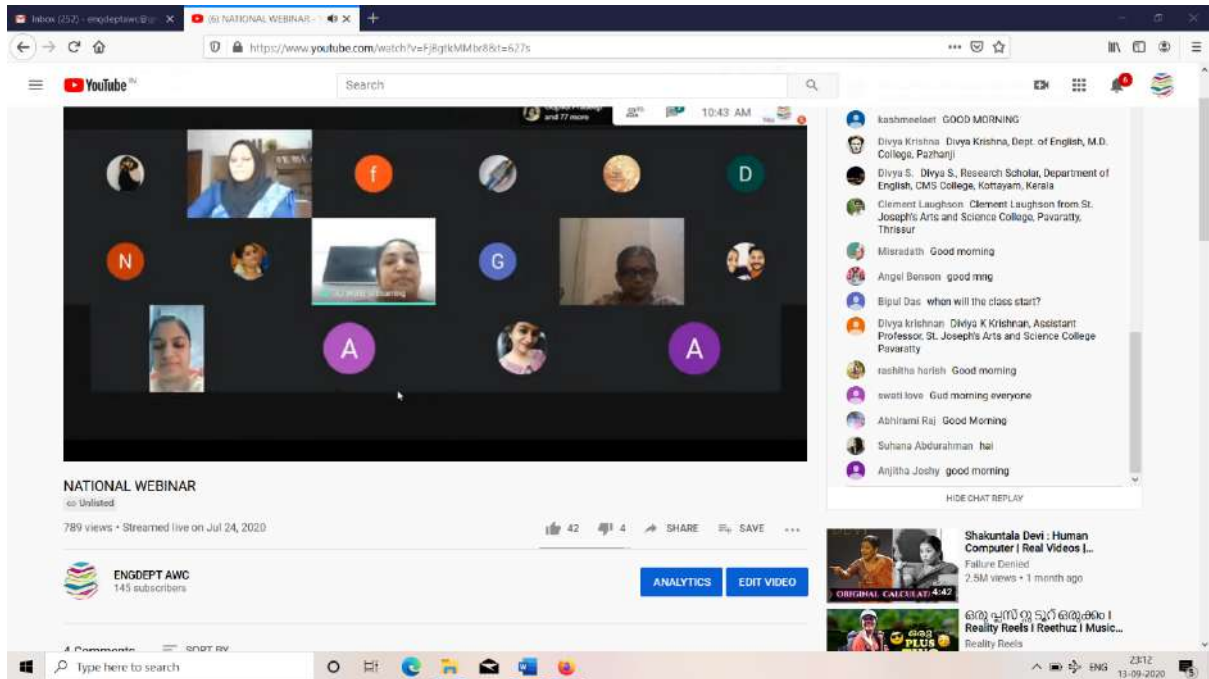


Karate Day Observation

ONLINE QUIZ COMPETITION ON POSTMODERNISM

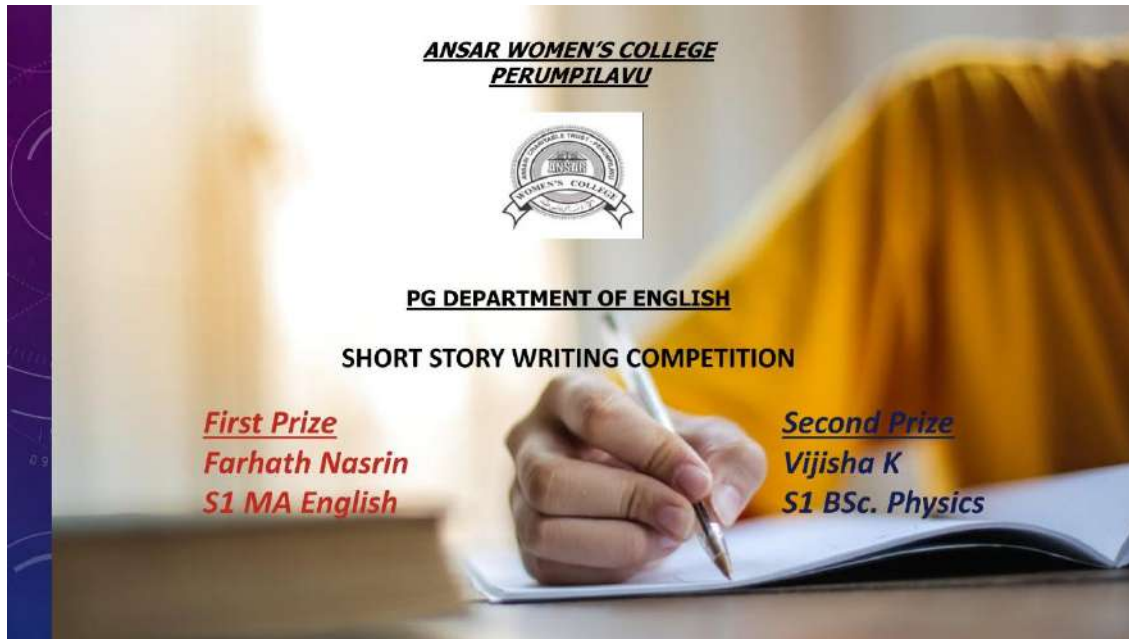

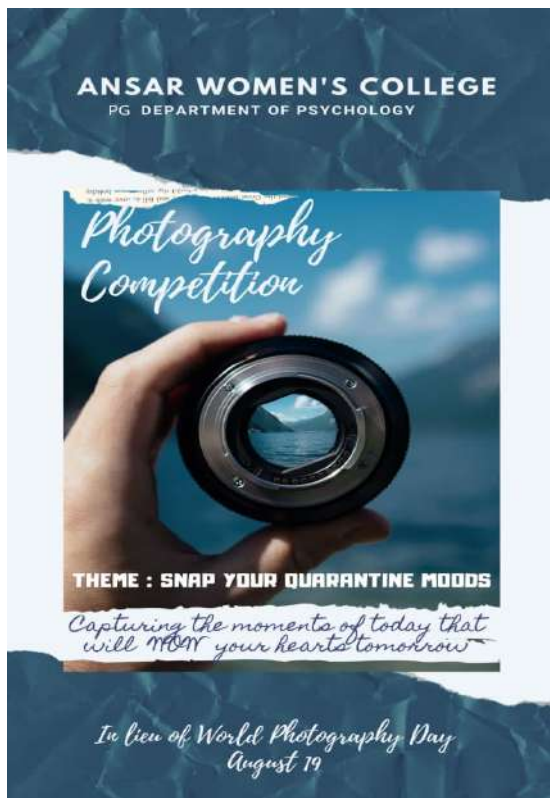

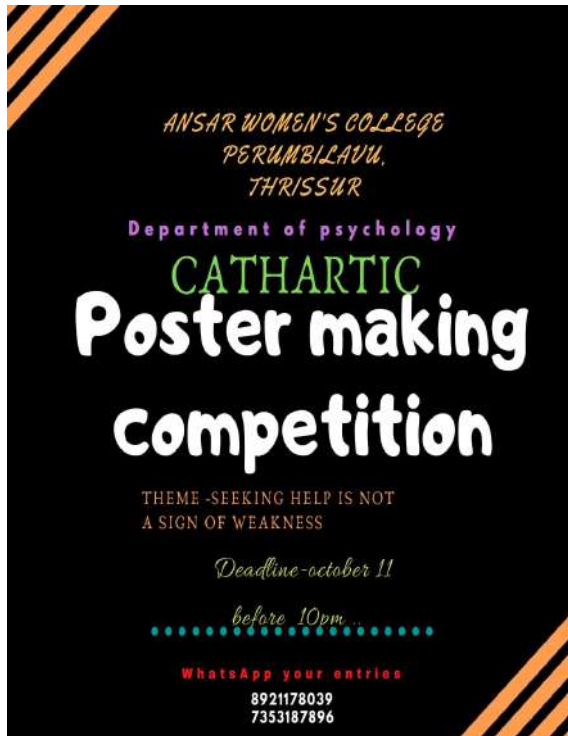
“SEEKING HELP IS NOT A SIGN OF HAPPINESS”

10 October 2020

The objective of World Mental Health Day is to raise awareness of mental health issues around the world and to mobilize efforts in support of mental health. This Day provides an opportunity for all stakeholders working on mental health issues to talk about their work, and what more needs to be done to make mental health care a reality for people worldwide. This year’s World Mental Health Day, on 10 October, comes at a time when our daily lives have changed considerably as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. The past months have brought many challenges: for health-care workers, providing care in difficult circumstances, going to work fearful of bringing COVID-19 home with them; for students, adapting to taking classes from home, with little contact with teachers and friends, and anxious about their futures; for workers whose livelihoods are threatened; for the vast number of people caught in poverty or in fragile humanitarian settings with extremely limited protection from COVID-19; and for people with mental health conditions, many experiencing even greater social isolation than before. And this is to say nothing of managing the grief of losing a loved one, sometimes without being able to say goodbye

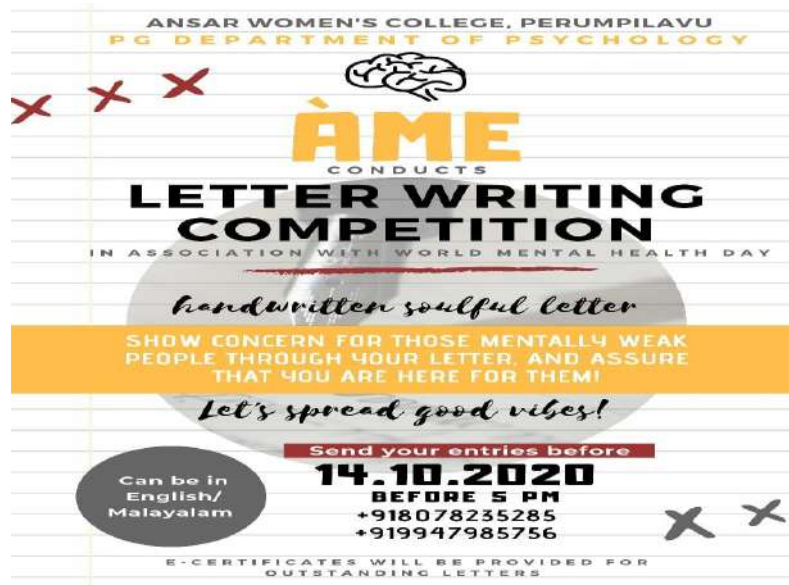


AME LETTER COMPETITION REPORT 2020

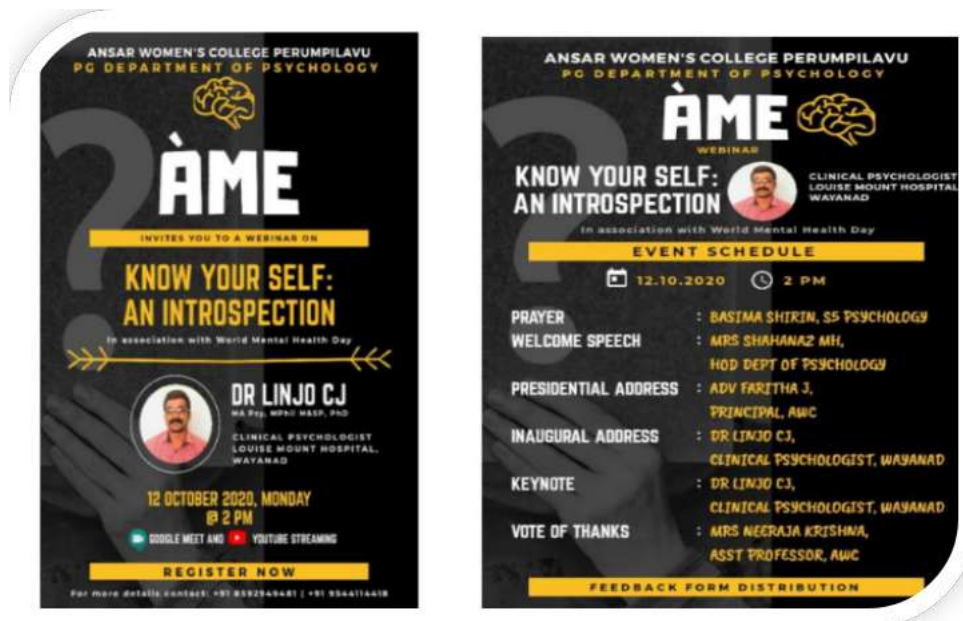

He also discussed speaking about self-knowledge, we are alluding to particular kind of knowledge – generally of an emotional or psychological kind. He emphasized that here the focus on the areas of self-knowledge that matter most in life: the areas concerned with the inner psychological core of the self. He remarked about the Introspection as central to philosophy of mind, both as a process worth study in its own right and as a court of appeal for other claims about the mind. The webinar ended with an interactive session where all the students clarified their doubts regarding the topic. Ms.

Neeraja Krishna, Assistant professor of our department delivered the vote of thanks. All the students relished and valued the session.



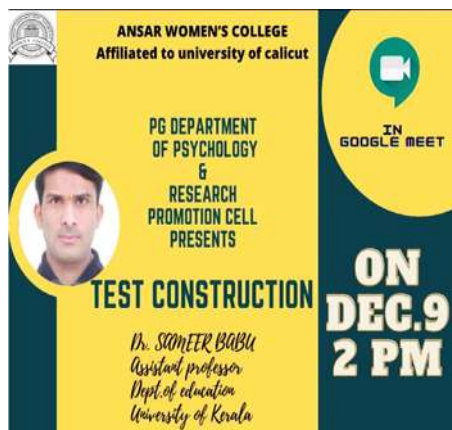
