

WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY- SPEAK UP COMPETITION


On the 5th of June 2021, the Energy Conservation Cell in collaboration with the PG Dept of Physics, observed the world environment day conducting a speak up


FICTIONAL STORY WRITING COMPETITION: ENVIRONMENT DAY

ONAM 2021






International Day for the Eradication of Poverty-Digital Collage Making

WEBINAR ON PHYSICS TODAY: CAREERS OPPORTUNITIES






WEBINAR ON STUDY ON PHOTONICS


NATIONAL WEBINAR: ORIGIN AND UTILIZATION OF PYRAMID




SCIENCE HUNT FOR STUDENTS AND TEACHERS



Seminar on Solar Power Plant: Extensional activity


