The Internship Policy of Ansar Women's College aims to provide students with experiential learning opportunities that complement academic learning and enhance employability, professional competence, and social responsibility in alignment with NEP 2020 and university regulations.

Objectives

To integrate practical and skill-based learning with the curriculum

To expose students to professional and organizational work environments

To develop employability skills such as communication, teamwork, ethics, and problem-solving

To promote community engagement and social awareness

Scope

This policy is applicable to all Undergraduate and Postgraduate students of the institution, as per university and departmental guidelines.

Internship Opportunities

Students may undertake internships in industries, educational institutions, NGOs, government/semi-government offices, research centres, media, IT, cultural and service sectors, or approved online platforms.

Duration and Mode

Internships shall be undertaken during semester breaks or as prescribed in the curriculum. The duration and mode shall be as per university norms and departmental requirements.



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Roles and Responsibilities

Institution / IQAC: Formulate guidelines, facilitate opportunities, and maintain documentation.

Departments: Identify suitable internship areas, mentor students, and assess outcomes.

Students: Complete internships responsibly and submit required reports and certificates.

Assessment and Documentation

Internship completion shall be evaluated through reports, presentations, or viva-voce as prescribed. Completion certificates and records shall be maintained for academic and accreditation purposes.

Review

The policy shall be reviewed periodically by IQAC and updated in accordance with university, NAAC, and NEP 2020 guidelines.
