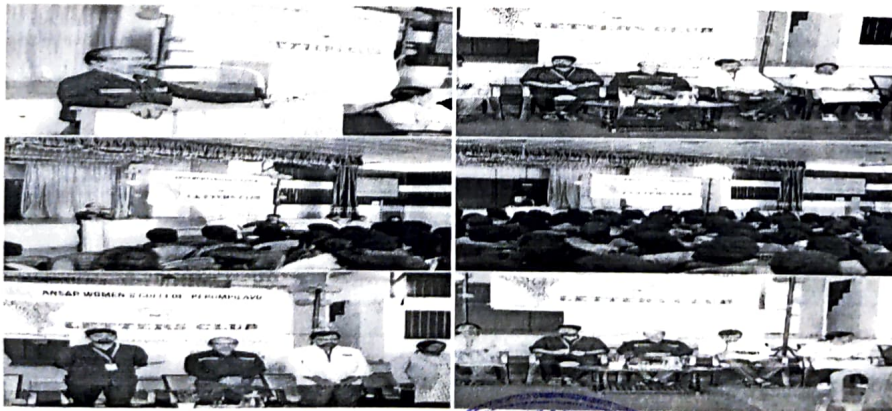

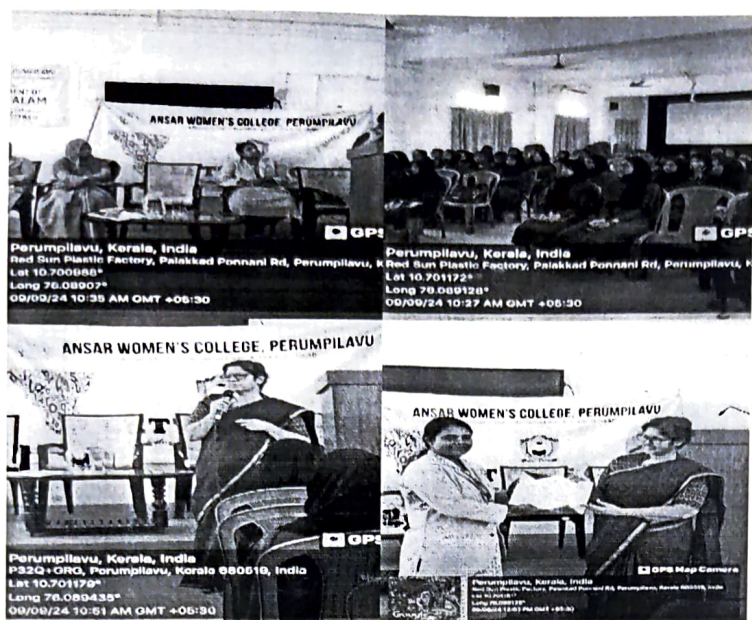


LIKHITHAM 9th September 2024

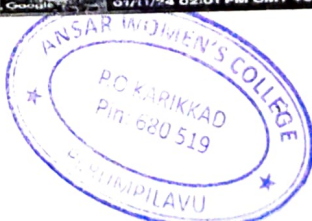

QUIZ COMPETITION, 01st November 2024

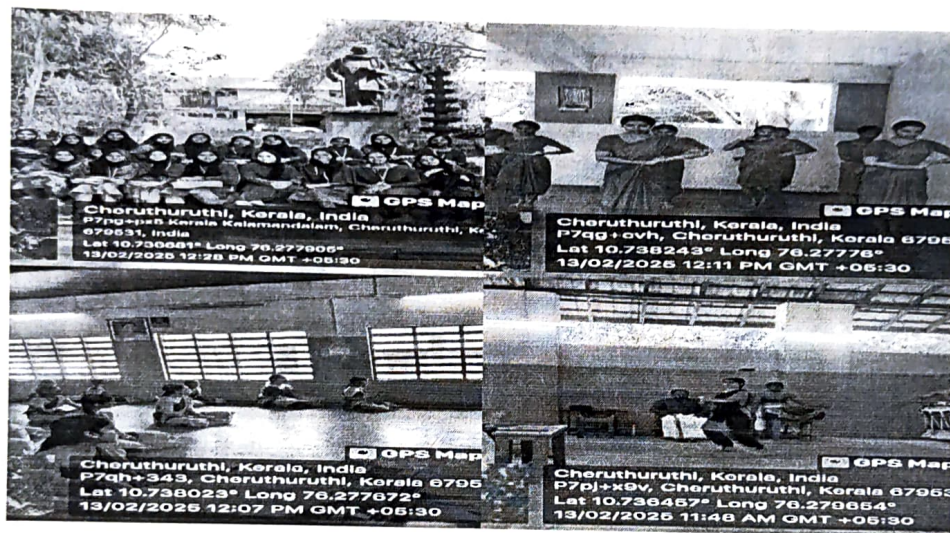
